ORDINANCE NO. 02 S. 1998

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AND PENALIZING MEAT VENDORS FROM SELLING HOT MEAT AT THE BATAC PUBLIC MARKET

WHEREAS, animals to be slaughtered for public consumption are quarantined for twenty-four (24) hours to safeguard the health of our constituents from possible diseases;

WHEREAS, in line with the Omnibus Tax Code of the Municipality, fees and charges on animals to be slaughtered are levied to augment our local sources of income;

WHEREAS, the practice of selling hot meat by some meat vendors is unfair to those who are willingly paying their fees to the Local Government Unit;

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Batac, Ilocos Norte that:

Section 1. Definition of terms as used in this Ordinance:

1. Meat - the flesh of animals used as food;

- 2. Hot Meat any meat sold at the public market that had not been quarantined and slaughtered at the Batac Slaughterhouse and inspected by the Meat Inspector of the Municipality;
- 3. *Quarantine* the enforced isolation for a fixed period of time. In the case of animals to be butchered 24 hours;
- 4. Animals a sentient living organism typically endowed with voluntary motion and sensation. Any such creature as distinguished from man like cows, horses, carabaos, pigs.

Section 2. All kinds of meat as mentioned in this Ordinance should be stamped by the Municipal Meat Inspector before being sold at the Batac Public Market;
