ORDINANCE NO. 6SP 2024 - 01

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND OBSERVING THE ANNUAL SEARCH FOR THE CLEANEST AND GREENEST SCHOOL IN THE CITY OF BATAC, AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF
