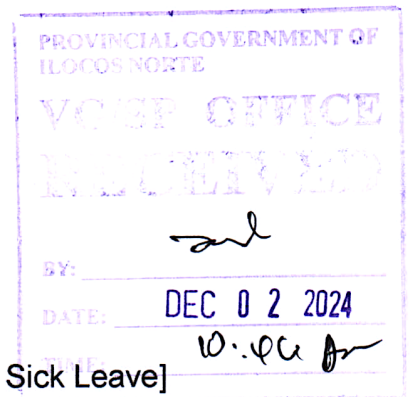

ORDINANCE NO. 6SP 2024 – 14

**AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE CONDUCT OF KATUWANG SA DIWA
AT GAWA PARA SA MASAGANANG ANI AT MATAAS NA KITA (KADIWA)
NG PANGULO IN THE CITY OF BATAC, ILOCOS NORTE**

WHEREAS, the “Katuwang sa Diwa at Gawa para sa Masaganang Ani at Mataas na Kita”, (KADIWA) ng Pangulo Program is a market linkage facilitation program aimed at making agri-products and other basic commodities accessible and affordable to the poor. It also seeks to establish an additional market for farmers and fisher folks to directly sell their products and increase their income;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the KADIWA ng Pangulo Program is reiterated by President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. during his State of the Nation Address (SONA) citing that “The KADIWA system enabled the public to buy goods at cheaper rates and the farmers to sell their crops without having to worry about transportation costs”;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular Number 2024-003 encouraging LGUs to set-up their respective KADIWA aiming to promote economic development through agricultural mechanisms and facilities which support enterprise development, linking local produce to markets, and facilitating job creation and livelihood especially to our farmers who are primarily engaged in sustainable local economic activities;

WHEREAS, the City Government had successfully launched its KADIWA ng Pangulo last February 15, 2024 at the Imelda Cultural Center and conducted the same in subsequent months resulting into significant benefits and impact to stakeholders especially the consuming public as to food supply and to farmers as producers highlighting their derived income from the implementation of the program;
